Keeping your student immunized is important to your child's health. Clay County Public Health Center provides thousands of immunizations to students from all over Clay County each year. The Clay County Public Health Center Immunization Clinic Registered Nurses will be offering all required and recommended school immunizations for **Smithville School District**.

The students eligible for the school immunization clinics must be in Middle School between the ages 11-14 and in High School between the ages 16-18. All students are eligible to receive this service regardless of insurance coverage. Clay County Public Health Center accepts uninsured, Medicaid, and most major insurance plans. **Be sure to verify coverage for preventative immunizations with your insurance provider prior to the clinic date to avoid any potential unknown fees or costs.** During the online registration process, you will need to have your insurance card available. The vaccines being offered are:

Middle School

- **Tdap (required)**
- **Meningococcal (required)**
- HPV9 (recommended)
- Influenza (recommended)

High School

- **Meningococcal (required)**
- Men B (recommended)
- Influenza (recommended)
- HPV9 (recommended)

If you would like your student(s) to receive any of these vaccines, **please register your child AT LEAST ONE WEEK PRIOR to the scheduled vaccination clinic.** Please encourage your student to have breakfast the day of the clinic.
