

## Change in Learning Mode Communication for Parents

When the district published its re-entry plan for the fall semester, parents were notified that they would have the opportunity to change the mode of learning for their students at semester. **If your student is currently learning virtually and you would like to change to in-person learning or if your student is currently learning in-person and you would like to change to virtual learning, this is your opportunity to do so.** You must complete this form for each student **by Friday, November 20** to initiate a change in learning mode.
