We would like to announce that we will have device pickup for our high school students next week, **Tuesday Aug 25th thru Friday Aug 28th from 7am to 7pm at the Performing Arts Center.** Any high school student that did not receive their Chromebook over the summer can pick up their device on those dates. If your device from last year was not turned in, you can also turn in that device so you do not incur a charge for a missing device. Typically devices would be handed out after school is in session; however, with some students virtual and other students face-to-face we wanted to get devices in students' hands immediately.

During this handout everyone entering the building will be required to wear a mask and social distancing will be enforced. We will provide a safe minimal contact environment for those picking up devices by propping open doors and cleaning areas often as required.
