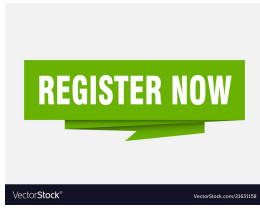

It is expected that all students wishing to park in the High school parking lot have a 2020-2021 parking pass assigned to them. Those students that do not by September 21, 2020 will be subject to fines as listed below.

SECOND OFFENSE-POSSIBLE TOWING OF THE VEHICLE WITH OWNER PAYING TOWING COST PLUS AND THE FINE ASSESSED BY THE SCHOOL

SHS will be holding an optional ACT practice test for current Juniors on Friday, October 23rd from 7:45 am-noon. The test will be given at the high school and students will be spread out to maintain physical distancing. Even though this is a virtual learning day, ACT testers will be expected to be in attendance at the high school. The purpose of this test is to provide students with a baseline score so they know what academic areas to work on before they take the official test.

Additionally, juniors may elect to participate in an ACT Virtual Bootcamp to be held on Wednesday, November 11 from 8am-noon. This is an interactive test prep with built-in breaks that students will access from home. Please consult your student's counselor if you have questions about whether the ACT is recommended. Typically, students pursuing post-secondary education take the ACT. It is required for admissions at many 4 year universities and is used as a placement test at community colleges.

In early November, you will be given an opportunity to sign up for a fee waiver to be used to take the official ACT for free on your own at a local testing center.
