Full Day of School - March 21st

Early Release - End of Quarter - March 22nd

Last Day of School - Early Release - June 7th, 2019

As a result of the ninth (9th) unplanned missed school day on Wednesday, February 27th, school will be in session on Friday, March 22nd (originally no school for spring break) to ensure the last day of the 2018-2019 school year is on Friday, June 7th.

Secondly, the last day for 3rd quarter will be on Friday, March 22nd and will be an early dismissal for staff professional development (2.5 hours early). Thursday, March 21st will be a full day (regular schedule).

If we are forced to miss a tenth (10th) day, it will be forgiven by the Missouri Department of Education. If we are forced to miss an eleventh (11th) day, it will be made up on Monday, March 25th. If a twelfth (12th) day is necessary, it will be forgiven by the Missouri Department of Education. If a thirteenth (13th) day is necessary, it will be made up on Friday, April 19th. A fourteenth (14th) day and beyond will be forgiven.

Regardless, the last day of the 2018-2019 school year will be on Friday, June 7th (early dismissal)

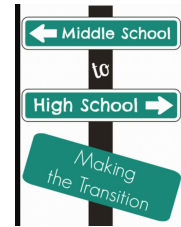

Vaccination Clinic Offered to 7th Grade Students!

The state of MO requires that all incoming 8th grade students have the Tdap and Meningitis vaccinations prior to enrollment. To make this more convenient for our families, we have partnered with the Clay County Public Health Center to host a **FREE** clinic at the Middle School to administer these vaccinations! Your insurance company will be notified that your child received the vaccine, but these will **not** be charged to your insurance, you do **not** have to pay for them AND a parent does not need to take the student to get them done. These vaccinations will be given here at the **Middle School on March 7th** during the regular school day.
