

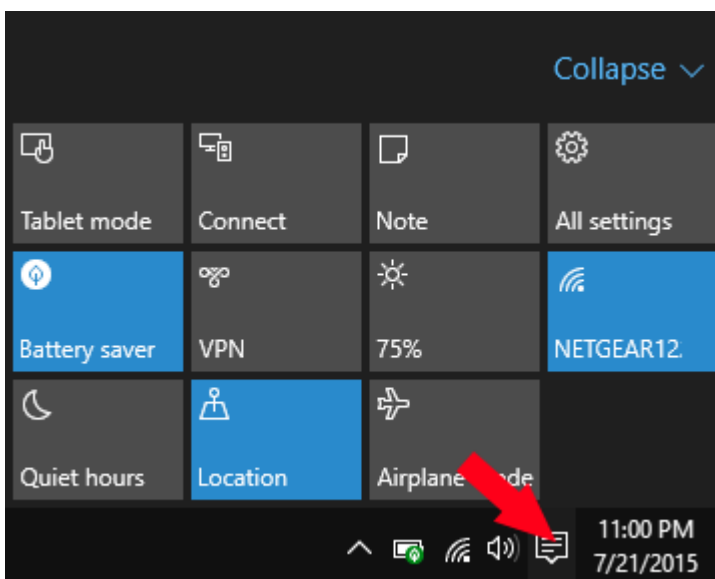
Connect to a projector using WiDi

Steps

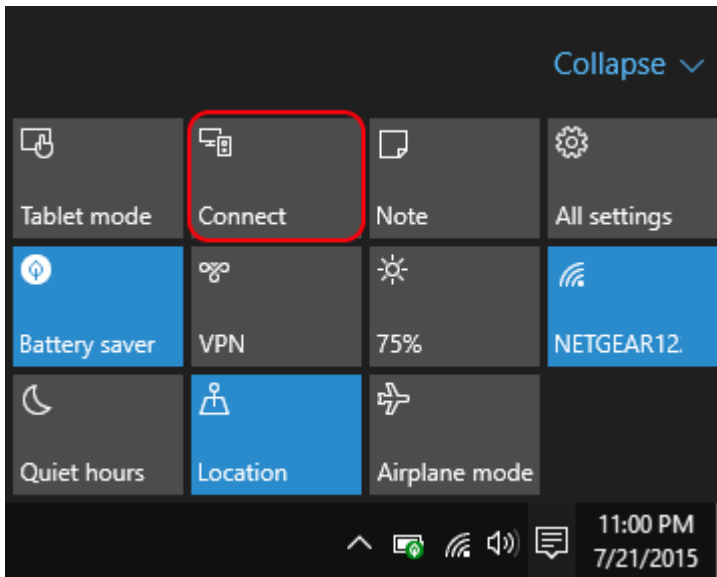
1. Change the Projector input source to HDMI using the Projector remote(on the remote use the 'video' or 'source search' buttons, some Projectors may have HDMI 1 and HDM2). The WiDi Ready to connect screen similar to below should appear.



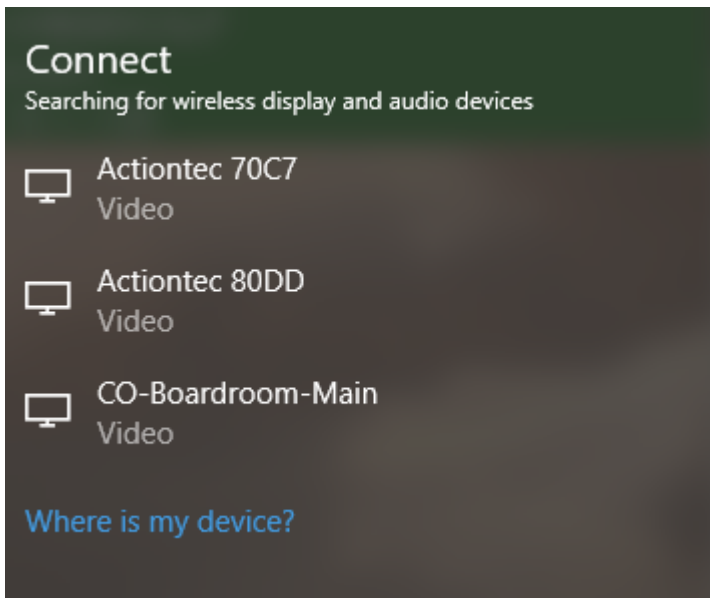
2. Swipe from right edge of the screen toward the middle to open the "Action Center" or click the icon in the bottom right as shown below. You can also use "Windows key + K" to go directly to step 4.



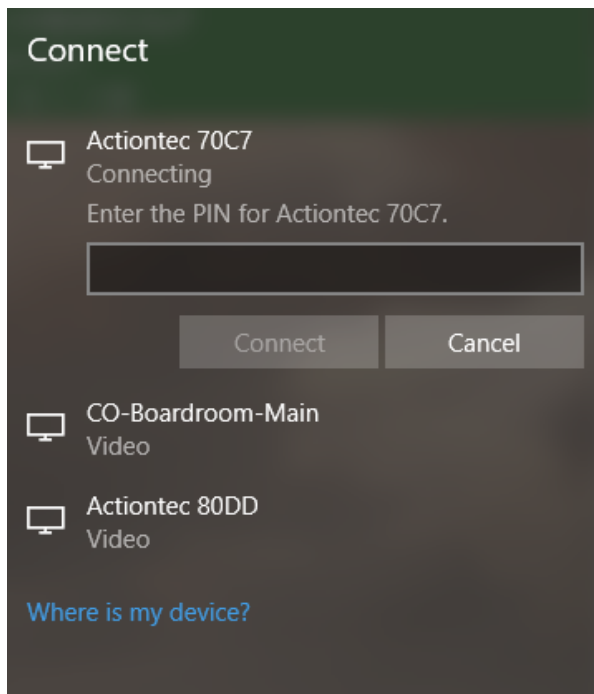
3. Then click on "Connect".



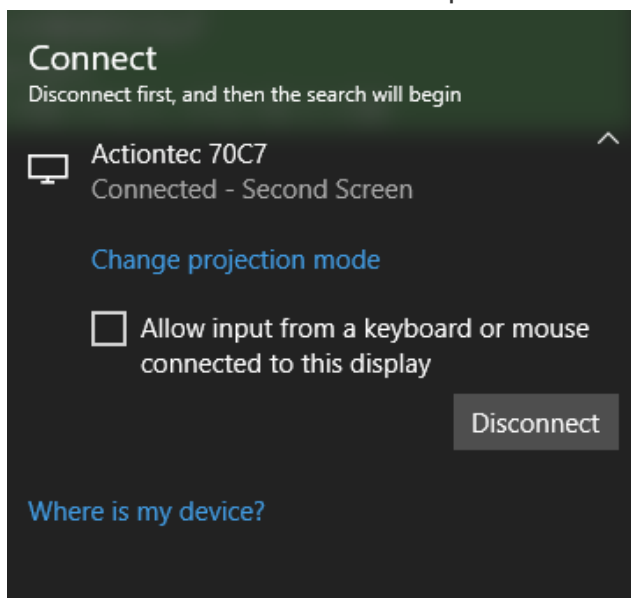
4. The pane should now be showing a list of available devices to connect to.



5. Select the device you want to connect. Input in the PIN that is displayed on the Projector. If there is no PIN displayed on the Projector please ask an IT Tech about the PIN.



6. Windows will run the connection process and the image will displayed through the WiDi.



Note: To disconnect, open the "Action Center" > Project or "Windows key + P" to go to the project screen and then click on **Disconnect**. There are also options located there to duplicate your screen to the WiDi or use the WiDi as an extended screen.
